



Latah Trail Fun Run

Come help us celebrate the completion of the Latah Trail!

Palouse Road Runners is sponsoring a run/walk to introduce the Palouse residents and others to the trail system that now extends from Pullman in the west to Troy in the east via the Chipman Trail, Paradise Path, and the just completed Latah Trail.

In the spirit of openness to a wide cross section of the community, this will be a non-competitive event with your choice of distance from 1 mile to 5 miles. Northwest River Supplies has generously made its warehouse parking lot available for registration, start and finish of the course, and post-run refreshments. The NRS warehouse is at the location of the former Tidyman's store on Blaine St, just south of the Troy Road.

Starting from the NRS parking lot, the course will follow Paradise Path eastward, continuing on the Latah Trail. There will be a number of marked turn around points at approximately half-mile intervals for out-and-back distances from 1 mile to 5 miles, based on each participant's choice.

Participants are asked to register between 9 and 10 AM on the day of the run, and the run will start at 10 AM. Timers will call out running times at the finish line. There will be a registration fee of \$10 for participants aged 18 and over, and \$5 for ages 6 to 17. This is to cover expenses, with all profits to be donated to the Latah Trail Foundation. **THERE ARE STILL BILLS OUTSTANDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE TRAIL.** Registrants will also receive a memento of the event.
